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Top Tips for Transition

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Students

- ◆ There will be **good days and bad days**, friendship issues will happen – they'll be old news in no time
- ◆ Come and talk to us if you're having **issues**, don't hide at home!
- ◆ **Every day counts** - if you're a little bit unwell come in and we will send you home if needed.
- ◆ **Detention** is not the end of the – accept responsibility, move on!
(...and yes, some of these are after school)

Parents

- ◆ **Communicate** through the **planner, email** and **reception** not directly with your child to discourage mobile device use
- ◆ Give them a hand with **organisation and routines** - but don't do it for them
- ◆ Let us know if there is a **family issue** that could affect the child's behaviour/welfare in school, however small.
- ◆ Make sure you know the **school uniform** rules so you're not talked into allowing haircuts, piercings, false nails etc. which are against the school rules.

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Induction Day



September 2024

Year 7 students start back **a day earlier** than the rest of the school on **Tuesday 3rd September** to allow them to settle in. The rest of the school returns on **Wednesday 4th September**.

Key Points

- Supported by Y10 Peer Supporters
- Double length tutor period to get to know their fellow tutees
- Start their timetable with three subject lessons.
- All transport will run as normal
- All students will receive a free lunch from the canteen.

Tutor Parents' Evening

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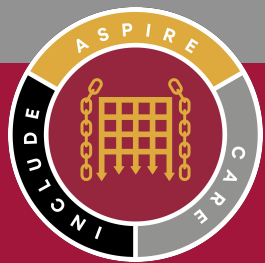


October 2024
