





Top Tips for Transition

Students

- There will be good days and bad days, friendship issues will happen – they'll be old news in no time
- Come and talk to us if you're having issues, don't hide at home!
- **Every day counts** if you're a little bit unwell come in and we will send you home if needed.
- ◆ Detention is not the end of the accept responsibility, move on!
 (...and yes, some of these are after school)

Parents

- Communicate through the planner, email and reception not directly with your child to discourage mobile device use
- ◆ Give them a hand with **organisation and routines** but don't do it for them
- Let us know if there is a **family issue** that could affect the child's behaviour/welfare in school, however small.
- Make sure you know the **school uniform** rules so you're not talked into allowing haircuts, piercings, false nails etc. which are against the school rules.


